INSTRUCTIONS TO EXHIBIT YOUR DESIGN AT THE FLOWER SHOW:

- 1. Complete the attached registration form and return it to the Children's Department desk at Emma S. Clark Memorial Library by no later **than Monday, September 14th.**
- 2. Bring your completed design to the library on **Wednesday**, **September 16th between** 7:00 p.m. 8:30 p.m. <u>OR</u> Thursday, **September 17th between 2:30** p.m. 4:00 p.m.
- 3. When you submit your completed design, include a 3x5 card with the names of the plant material used written in pencil and clearly write your name and grade on the back of the card. The TVGC will write all the details on the entry form and will transport your design to the Wang Center at Stony Brook University.
- 4. Your exhibit must be picked up from the Wang Center at **4:00 p.m. on Sunday, Sept. 20th** or you may pick it up at the Library after 11:00 a.m. on Monday, September 21st.
- 5. Participants must be students in the Three Village School district between grades 1 and 3.

EXHIBIT RULES YOU NEED TO KNOW:

- 1. Advance entry is required by September 14, 2015.
- 2. A design entered in competition must be the work of only one exhibitor (You) and your name must appear on the entry card which will be provided by the TVGC.
- 3. Youth Exhibits are judged by NGC Standard System of Awarding. Scores of 90 or above are required to place Youth Top Exhibitor Awards.
- 4. Some plant material (fresh or dried flowers and/or leaves) must be used in every exhibit.
- 5. No artificial flowers, foliage fruits or vegetables (e.g. silk or plastic) are permitted
- 6. Fresh plant material may not ever be treated in any manner (e.g. painted a different color or use of a polishing solution to make it shine). Treated plant material may be used only in its dried state.
- 7. Religious symbols used must be displayed in a respectful manner and in accordance with policies of local religious organizations.
- 8. The American flag or other national flags are not to be incorporated into any competitive design nor used as underlays, swags, or the like.
- 9. Living representation from the animal kingdom is not permitted.
