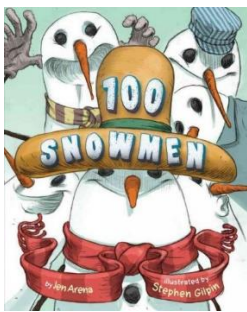


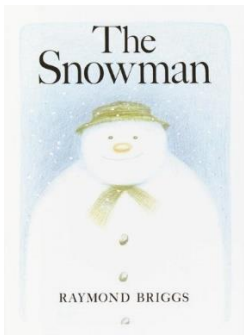

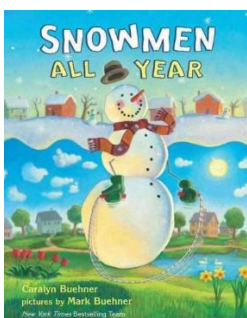
## Books and eBooks:



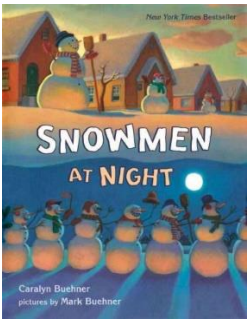

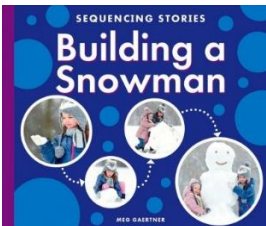
**[Snowmen at Night](#)** by Caralyn Buehner (E BUE): A young boy imagines that snowmen play games at night when no one is watching.



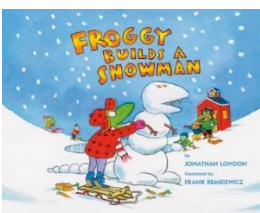

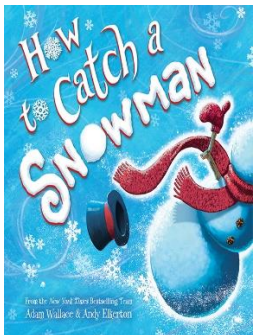
[All You Need for a Snowman](#) by Alice Schertle (E SCH): Lists everything that one needs to build the perfect snowman, from the very first snowflake that falls.



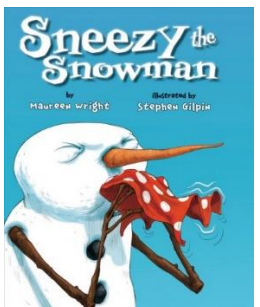
[Mouse's First Snow](#) by Lauren Thompson (E THO): Mouse tries many new things when he and his father go out and play in the snow.

## Snowmen Rhymes & Songs:

### I Built a Little Snowman

### I'm a Little Snowman - (*Sing to the tune of I'm a Little Teapot*)

I'm a little snowman short and fat,  
Here are my buttons, here is my hat. (*point to buttons, point to hat*)  
When the sun comes out, I cannot play, (*arms over head like the sun, shake your head*)  
I just slowly melt away! (*wiggle fingers and lower arms to show melting*)

I'll have to make more on another snowy!

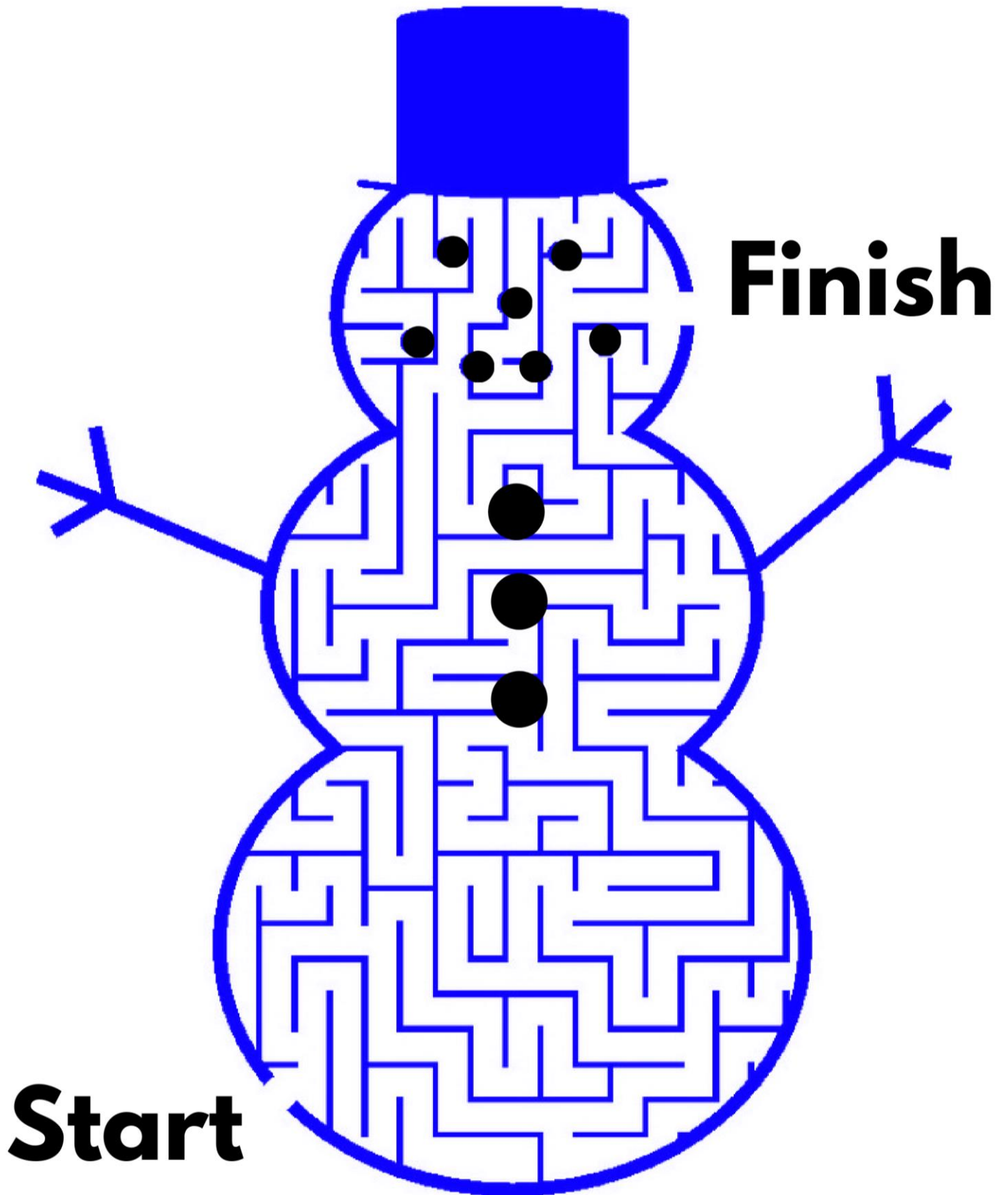






## Snowman Maze:
