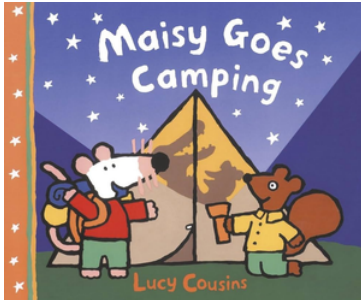


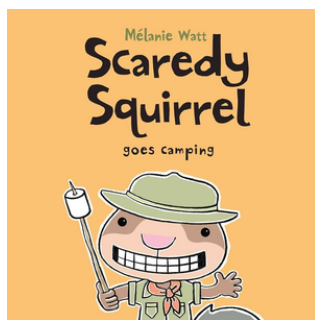
Adventurous Picture Books

Maisy the mouse and her friends spend a night **camping** under the stars. Also available as an [eBook](#).

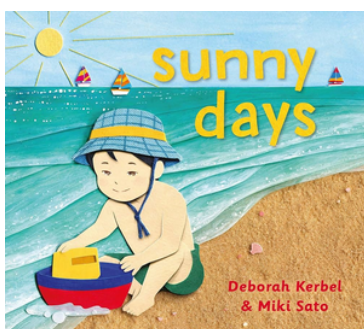


[Herbie's Big Adventure](#) (E POH) by Poh, Jennie:
When his mother sends Herbie the young hedgehog out on his first big foraging **adventure**, a big wind sweeps him far from home.

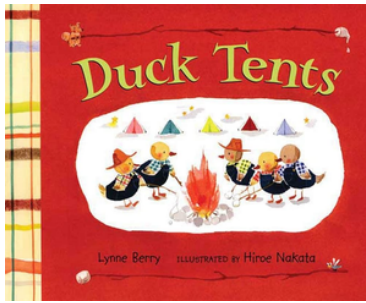


[Scaredy Squirrel Goes Camping](#) (E WAT) by Watt, Mélanie:

Scaredy squirrel doesn't like **camping** but must go into the woods to find an electrical outlet for his TV.

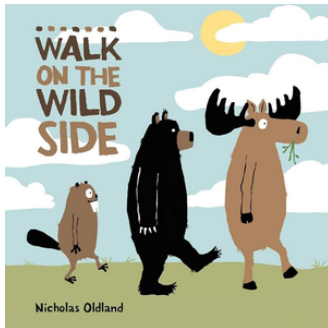


[Sunny Days](#) (E KER) by Kerbel, Deborah:
Rhyming couplets celebrate the activities and **adventures** made possible by sunny weather from a preschooler's perspective.



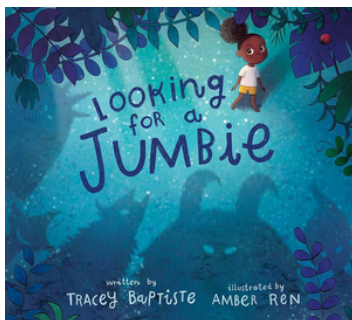
Duck Tents (E BER) by Berry, Lynne:

While on a **camping trip**, five little ducks pitch tents, go fishing, toast marshmallows around a campfire, and face frightening night noises.



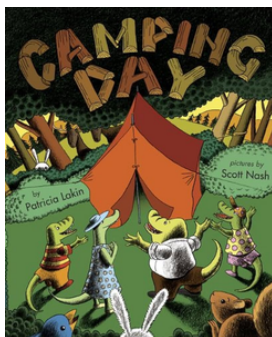
Walk On The Wild Side (E OLD) by Oldland, Nicholas:

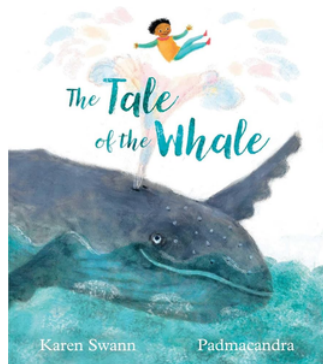
Hike (E OSW) by Oswald, Pete:

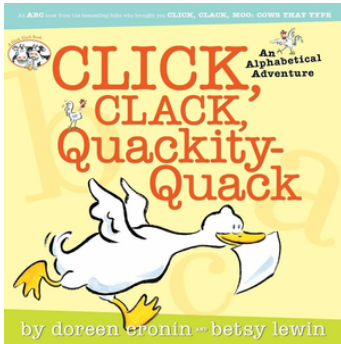
The Tale of the Whale (E SWA) by Swann, Karen:

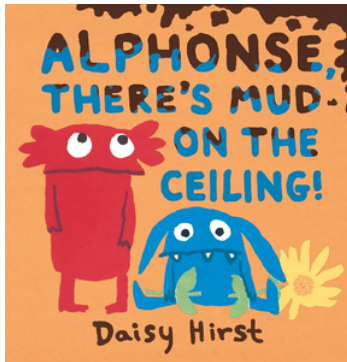
The Night Walk (E DOR) by Dorléans, Marie:

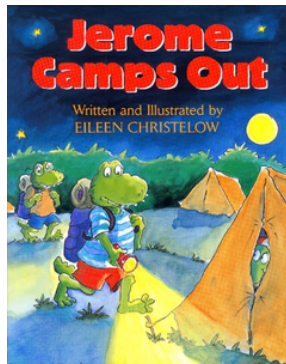
Click Clack, Quackity-Quack: An Alphabetical Adventure (E ABC 123 CRO) by Cronin, Doreen:

An assortment of animals gathers for a picnic. This alphabetical **adventure** for young fans of Duck brings alphabet books to a whole new level.



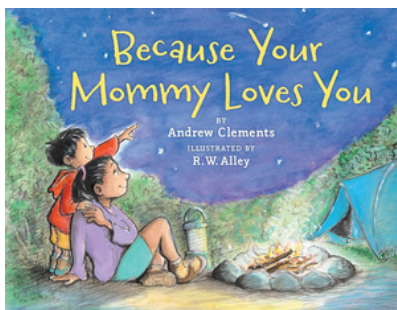
Alphonse, There's Mud on the Ceiling! (E HIR) by Hirst, Daisy:

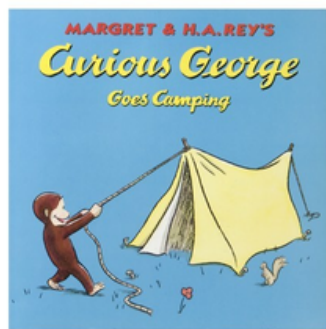
Jerome Camps Out (E CHR) by Christelow, Eileen:

by Rey, H. A.:

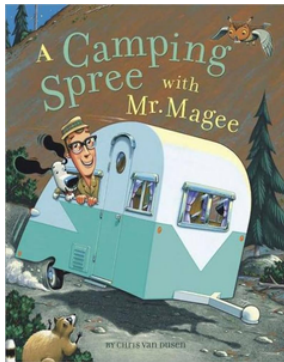
Curious George gets into mischief while **camping** but is able to redeem himself in an emergency. Also available as an [eBook](#).

Bumbling Papa Bear tries to help the Bear Scouts earn their merit badges in **hiking**.



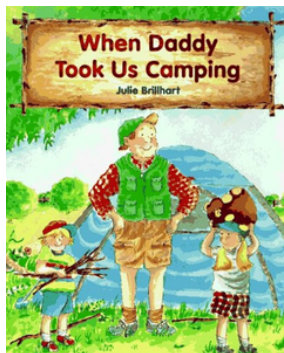
[A Camping Spree With Mr. Magee](#) (E VAN) by Van Dusen, Chris:

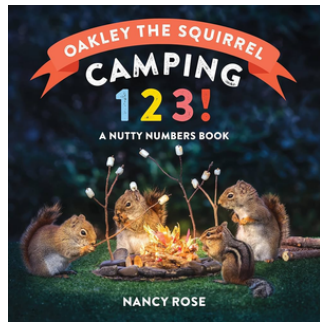
[When Daddy Took Us Camping](#) (E BRI) by Brillhart, Julie:

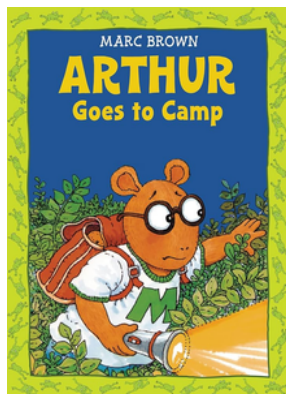
Oakley the Squirrel: Camping 1, 2, 3! (E ABC 123 ROS) by Rose, Nancy:

Learn how to count with Oakley as he experiences the fun of a **camping trip**.



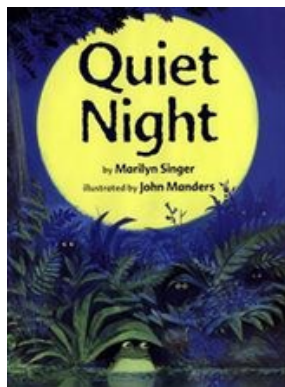
Secret, Secret Agent Guy (E BIG) by Bigwood, Kira:
