Wassily Kandinsky was a famous Russian artist who lived from 1866 to 1944. He is well known for his abstract paintings. Abstract art doesn't need to look realistic or close to anything in real life. Instead, abstract art uses shapes, lines and colors to create an image. One of Kandinsky's most famous paintings is called *Concentric Circles*. You'll see that it looks like several separate painted canvases joined together - here is an image of the painting:



Instructions:

Each participant will paint a canvas panel with ONE set of circles. The goal is to join everyone's paintings together for a Kandinsky inspired work of art in the Children's Library. Here is an example of a finished canvas panel:



Be creative and use unique colors for your circles! Let Kandinsky inspire you, but don't copy his work!
