For children in grades 3 - 5:

All who serve our nation deserve to be thanked for their commitment and bravery. A letter expressing your gratitude can go a long way to lift their spirits and show how much we appreciate them!

**Each letter must be handwritten, a minimum of 10 sentences long and follow the guidelines below.**

Completed letters should be dropped off at the Children's Reference Desk. Please include a separate piece of paper with your child's name, school, grade, and an email address where the community service certificate can be sent. Each letter that follows the guidelines will earn .5 hours of community service. There is a limit of 10 letters per month, which earn 5 hours of credit. **General Guidelines:**

- All letters should begin with "Dear Hero"
- FIRST NAMES ONLY - do not include your last name. You can include your age.
- Express your thanks for their service and let them know you support them
- Keep things light - be positive!
- Share general information about yourself - family, pets, favorite sports, hobbies, or other interests
- Decorate your letters with coloring and drawings

**Sample sentences to get you started (letters must be a minimum of 10 sentences):**

- Thank you for serving America - come home soon!
- Thank you for defending our country. You are my hero.
- Thank you for keeping us safe.
- Thank you for serving our country - be safe.
- I pray that you come home safely.

**Ideas of things to share about yourself:**
